## 2012 BRANDLIN ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

MOUNT VEEDER, NAPA VALLEY | ESTATE GROWN

### Jancis Robinson-Napa Cab lightens up

Brandlin Estate Cabernet Sauvignon (\$60) was one of only 12 Napa Cabernet producers selected by the NVV for this prestigious tasting. Others included Paul Hobbs (\$175), J Davies (\$90), Shafer Hillside Select (\$250), Realm (\$165) and Spottswoode (\$175) among others. 17.5 pts (highest score for the 2012 vintage)

*“You cannot taste or talk about Brandlin Cabernet Sauvignon without acknowledging the impact of the site... Steep rocky soils and a moderate climate render an intense, black fruited concentration and powerful backbone of tannin that make this wine so unique.”*

Brandlin is a Napa Valley estate that produces wine from a small, historic vineyard in the Mount Veeder appellation. Overlooking Napa Valley from its 1,200 foot perch, the estate is planted to 38 acres of Bordeaux varieties. These sustainably farmed, low-yielding vines produce intensely concentrated grapes, resulting in wines that eloquently express this rare and rugged mountain site. The wines pay homage to the Brandlin family, which began farming wine grapes on Mount Veeder in the 1870s and established the Brandlin Vineyard in 1926. In 1998 Cuvaison Estate Wines was honored by Chester Brandlin with rights to purchase Brandlin Vineyard. Today, we remain dedicated to maintaining the original ten acres of old vine Zinfandel and continuing the family’s tradition of nurturing and farming the vineyard by hand.
